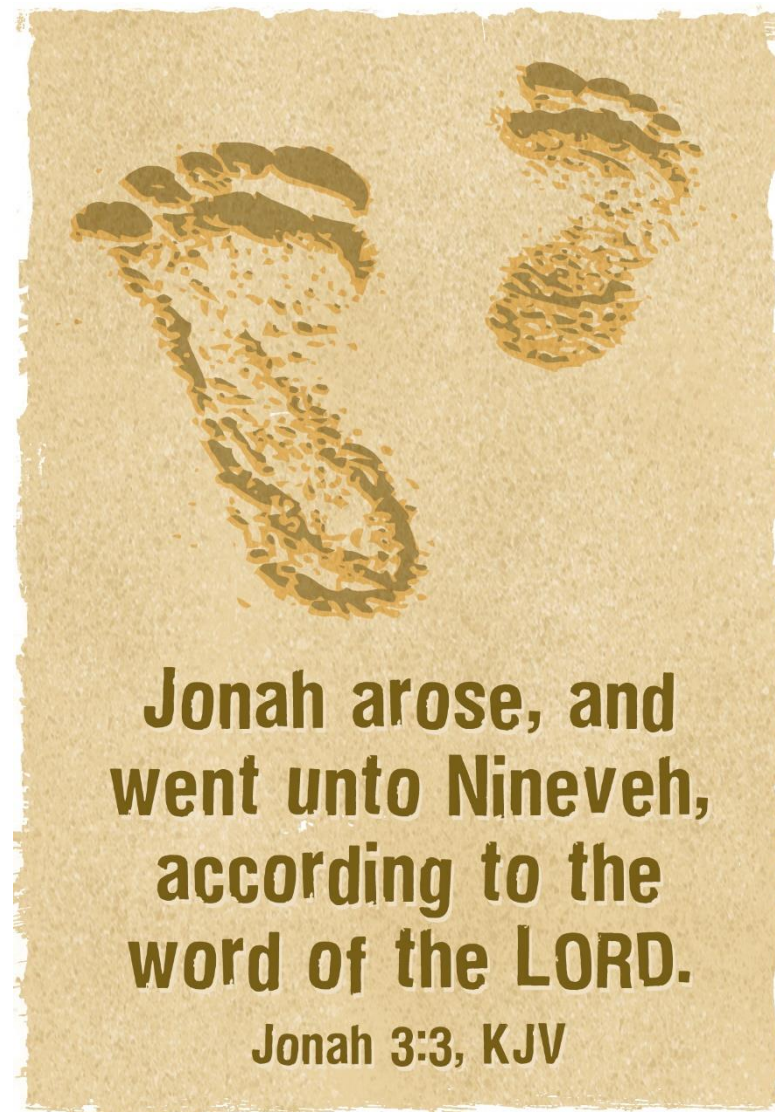

Finance Update

December 31, 2023

The offerings in December were 15.7% higher than our average monthly giving in December for the past 5 years. On December 31st the annual offerings were \$127,030.37, which was 3.6% below our Budgeted amount of \$130,400, but 1.4% higher than the 5 year rolling average for the year. The year ended with a deficit in the General Fund of \$7,966.17. That deficit was funded with funds from the United Methodist Foundation's Grant, we received in 2020. We are confident that God will continue to provide Chapel Hill resources so we can continue to work on the Church's Mission.
